

A New Look at Stewardship, Kaleidoscope Institute Style Bible Study to Try

Your Stewardship committee and CTK's Bible Study group have been using the Kaleidoscope Institute style of Bible Study which reads the same passage three times.

After the first reading, ask each person to share (or ponder yourself):

A word, phrase, or image that comes to mind when you read/hear the text

After the second reading, ask each person to share (or ponder yourself):

What does this text teach you about "X" based on the message?

After the third reading, ask each person to share (or ponder yourself):

What does God invite you to do, change or be through this passage?



We've found the approach to be thought provoking and often leads to new understandings and encourage you to try the method individually or amongst friends and family.

It's best within a group if someone agrees to lead the process and identify a question after the second reading, "What does this text teach you about "X" based on the message?" Googling the passage may result in a question or two and your group could agree to contemplate more than one question if desired.
